SURFACE PREPARATION

It is essential you prepare your surfaces correctly before you begin painting - this will give you the best finish and make your paint last longer. Each Medal Paints product comes with a comprehensive set of instructions on the packaging detailing how to prepare the surfaces so be sure to spend some time looking at them before you start.

Cracks, nail holes and other surface imperfections should be filled with Medal Crack Filler and sanded smooth. Once filled, paint over with a Medal Plaster Primer before you paint on your

Rusty surfaces must be cleaned and primed with a steel primer to prevent rust from spreading.

Scrape off any loose or flaking

The most important step is to clean the surface from all dust. dirt and grime. Medal Sugar Soap is a mild but effective cleaner that has been specifically developed to remove dirt, wax, grease and grime from painted surfaces. It is suitable for both Enamel and PVA.



PLASTER BOND

An excellent bonding agent, providing a strong bond onto new cement & gypsum plaster and can be used as a keying agent with tile adhesive or grout.

Paint does not stick to smooth, polished surfaces like plastic so sand first and then prime to ensure a good finish.
