## **DESCRIPTION:**

Medal Walls & Ceilings Acrylic PVA is a good quality paint, which can be used for all interior and exterior surfaces. This product has excellent filling and hiding power properties. It can be applied to Cement Plastered Walls, Ceilings and on other areas where a matt finish is required.

### **SURFACE PREPRATION:**

<u>New Surfaces</u>: Surface/s must be thoroughly clean, dry and in sound condition before painting.

**Concrete/Cement Plaster:** Apply one coat of Medal Plaster Primer, followed by two coats of Medal Walls & Ceilings Acrylic Pva.

**Asbestos/Fibre Cement:** Apply one coat of Medal Plaster Primer, followed by two coats of Medal Walls & Ceilings Acrylic Pva.

**Iron & Steel:** Apply one coat of Medal Dual Steel Primer, followed by one coat of Medal Universal Undercoat and two coats of Medal Walls & Ceilings Acrylic Pva.

**Timber/Wood:** Apply one coat of Medal Pink Wood Primer, followed by one coat of Medal

Universal Undercoat and two coats of Medal Walls & Ceilings Acrylic Pva.

**Gypsum Plaster (Rhinolite/Rhinoglide):** Apply one coat of Medal Plasterbond or Plaster Primer, followed by two coats of Medal Walls & Ceilings Acrylic Pva.

Previously Painted Surfaces: Thoroughly clean and prepare surface by removing all dirt, grease, grime and flaking paint before painting. Powdery surfaces must be treated with one coat of Medal Plasterbond, prior to applying two coats of Medal Acrylic Pva. Enamel based surfaces must be cleaned and prepared correctly. Sand lightly and apply one coat of Medal Universal Undercoat, followed by two coats of Medal Walls & Ceilings Acrylic Pva.

#### APPLICATION:

Stir the contents thoroughly before use. This product should be applied without thinning. For colour consistency, ensure that batch numbers are the same on all cans. Apply this product with a paintbrush or (furpile / lambswool) paint roller, and allow +/- 4 hours drying time between coats. Allow paint to cure (hard dry) for 7 days before attempting to clean the surface. Do not apply when rain is imminent. Clean tools (brushes & rollers) with Water immediately after use.

## **SPREADING RATE:**

This product will cover approximately 6-8m² /litre, depending on surface porosity.
