1. PRODUCT USES

New and previously painted surfaces made from Cement Plaster, Concrete, and Brick & Primed Gypsum Plaster. Asbestos/Fibre Cement Fascias & Ceiling boards.

Primed Metal & Wooden Surfaces.

3. SURFACE PREPARATION

New Surfaces: Surface must be thoroughly clean, dry and in sound condition before painting.

Concrete/ Cement Plaster: Apply one coat of Professional Trade Waterbased Plaster Primer, followed by two coats of Medal Low Sheen Acrylic PVA.

Asbestos/Fibre Cement: Apply one coat of Professional Trade Waterbased Plaster Primer, followed by two coats of Medal Low Sheen Acrylic PVA.

Iron & Steel: Apply one coat of Medal Dual Steel Primer, followed by one coat of Professional Trade Universal Undercoat and two coats of Medal Low Sheen Acrylic PVA.

Timber/Wood: Apply one coat of Medal Pink Wood Primer, followed by one coat of Professional Trade Universal Undercoat and two coats Medal Low Sheen Acrylic PVA.

Gypsum Plaster (Rhinolite/Rhinoglide): Apply one coat of Prof trade Waterbased Plaster Primer, followed by two coats of Medal Low Sheen Acrylic PVA.

<u>Previously Painted Surface</u>: Thoroughly clean and prepare surface by removing all dirt, grease, grime and flaking paint before painting. Powdery surfaces must be treated with one coat of Professional Trade Plasterbond, prior to applying two coats of Medal Low Sheen Acrylic PVA, Enamel based surfaces must be cleaned and prepared correctly. Sand lightly and apply one coat of Professional Trade Universal Undercoat, followed by two coats of Medal Low Sheen Acrylic PVA.

4. APPLICATION

Stir the contents thoroughly before use. This product should be applied without thinning. For colour consistency, consistency, ensure that batch numbers are the same on all cans. Apply this product with a paintbrush or (furpile/lambswool) paint roller, and allow +/- 4 hours drying time between coats.

Allow paint to cure (hard dry) for 7 days before attempting to clean the surface. Do not apply when rain is imminent. Clean tools (brushes & rollers) with water immediately after use.

Tint Bases - Clear , Deep and Pastel

This product will cover approximately 7-9m² / litre, depending on surface porosity.
